Welcome to UPF-BSM, the management school of Pompeu Fabra University, a university internationally recognized for its level of excellence in teaching and research.



## **Academic calendar**

The Academic calendar is divided into 3 terms:

- 1st Term: September- December (NOT eligible for exchange)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Term: January March (ELIGIBLE for exchange)
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Term: April June (ELIGIBLE for exchange)

Course offer QTEM exchange students can attend the Elective courses

offered during the 2nd and/or 3rd term.

#### Note:

- Some of the courses may have limited enrolment.
- Students will receive the timetable several weeks before the beginning of each term.
- Elective courses will be carried out in case of reaching a minimum number of enrolled students. The final offer for each academic year may be adapted depending on the academic planning.

#### Usual work load

60 ECTS per academic year / 20 ECTS per Term

Elective courses are worth 4 ECTS each

Each term consists of 10 class weeks + exam period.

The number of credits to be taken by exchange students should

be determined by their home school.

# Language of teaching

Courses are taught only in English.

## **Learning expectations**

Classes may be conducted in any one of these formats or a combination thereof: lectures, classroom discussions, case studies, individual and group projects, term papers, student projects and dissertations.

Every course will have a clear calendar of sessions, and this will be made available to the students on the first day of the term.

Minimum attendance of 80% is required in every course. The size of the class depends on the number of students opting for a particular course.

### **Grading system**

The Spanish grading System is based on a scale from 0 to 10, where 5 is the minimum passing mark.

exams periods.
